

Special Session IPSS'2015
Product-service system approaches for urban transport sharing planning and management

Scope

Urban transport systems have strongly evolved in the last years, leading to different paradigms and functional schemes that co-habit in cities. With the development of new mobility patterns, new services, based on resource sharing, have been proposed in cities (mainly car sharing, bike-sharing and last mile delivery services). Most of those schemes derive or can be related to product-service approaches. This is the case of car-sharing and bike-sharing systems, but also the new car rental services (where particulars do not buy a car but rent it, along a series of services) or new city logistics services (e-commerce and shopping services where the delivery service is included, freight tramways, mixed people-freight transport systems). This session will address the issues of planning and managing transport sharing services (for both people and freight) in a vision of product-service systems. Different planning and management issues are envisaged (at strategic, tactical and operational level) for different applications in people and goods transport systems.
